

NOTICE OF PROBABLE CAUSE DETERMINATION
AND INTENTION TO PROCEED TO PUBLIC HEARING

Please take notice that the undersigned, upon review of the investigation conducted in this matter, has determined that there is probable cause to credit the allegations of the Complaint that Respondents has violated Section 8-107 of the Administrative Code of the City of New York ("Administrative Code").

Specifically, there is probable cause to believe that Respondents' policy regarding access to an exercise room in its housing accommodation results in a disparate impact upon Complainant and other rent-regulated tenants based upon their age, in violation of Section 8-107(17) of the Administrative Code.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that it is the intention of the Law Enforcement Bureau to notice this case for public hearing if this matter is not promptly resolved by a conciliation agreement.
