## **Administrative Contract Agreement To Bring 71 Percent of City Labor Force Under Contract**

Includes Labor Deals for Uniformed Superior Officers

(New York, NY)— Following news that the administration reached a tentative \$413 million labor deal with uniformed city employees— including superior officers in the fire, police, sanitation and corrections departments—New York City Public Advocate Letitia James released the following statement:

“Tonight's contract agreement represents a major achievement for the Uniformed Superiors Officers and the administration. It's a recognition of the outstanding work our law enforcement professionals put forth on a daily basis and fulfills the Superior Officers' longstanding and principled demand for a fair contract.
